4.9 SPECIAL RATES FOR THE HANDICAPPED

4.9.1 Directory Assistance

There shall be no charge for up to fifty calls per billing cycle from lines or trunks servicing individuals with disabilities. The Carrier shall charge the prevailing tariff rates for every call in excess of fifty within a billing cycle.

4.9.2 Hearing and Speech Impaired Persons

Intrastate toll message rates are not time of day sensitive.

4.9.3 Telecommunications Relay Service

For intrastate toll calls received from the relay service, the Carrier will, when billing relay calls, discount relay service calls by 70 percent off of the otherwise applicable rate for a voice nonrelay call, including when the calling party is both hearing and visually impaired. The above discounts apply only to time-sensitive elements of a charge for the call and shall not apply to per call charges such as a credit card surcharge.

4.9 SPECIAL RATES FOR THE HANDICAPPED

4.9.1 Directory Assistance

There shall be no charge for up to fifty calls per billing cycle from lines or trunks servicing individuals with disabilities. The Carrier shall charge the prevailing tariff rates for every call in excess of fifty within a billing cycle.

4.9.2 Hearing and Speech Impaired Persons

Intrastate toll message rates are not time of day sensitive.

4.9.3 Telecommunications Relay Service

For intrastate toll calls received from the relay service, the Carrier will when billing relay calls discount relay service calls by 50 percent off of the otherwise applicable rate for a voice nonrelay call except that where either the calling party is both hearing and visually impaired, the call shall be discounted 80 percent off of the otherwise applicable rate for a voice nonrelay call. The above discounts apply only to time-sensitive elements of a charge for the call and shall not apply to per call charges such as a credit card surcharge.
