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49. AT&T PRISON COLLECT WITH CONTROLS SERVICES

49.1 General

AT&T Prison Collect with Controls Service is an AT&T Long Distance Service that permits inmates to place collect calls originated over the AT&T network from authorized telephone numbers in a Prison Administration controlled environment. Telephones subscribed for this service may be controlled by the Prison Administration for one or more of the following:

- duration of call
- call blocking
- time of day
- number of calls placed per individual
- permission restrictions
- restriction lists

Prison Collect with Controls Service is available at prisons in the state of Florida.

Prison Collect with Controls Service includes Operator Station Collect calls placed to locations within the state of Florida. Prison Collect with Controls Service calls cannot be converted from a Collect call to a Calling Card call by the billed party.

Prison Collect with Controls Service includes usage charges and a Service Charge per call. See Rate Schedule for rates.

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49. AT&T PRISON COLLECT WITH CONTROLS SERVICES

49.2 Rates and Charges

49.2.1 Bill Statement Fee

Customers who receive their intrastate AT&T Prison Collect calls charges as part of their local telephone company bill, will be assessed a Bill Statement Fee as specified in the Rate Schedule. This fee is in addition to all other rates and charges.

AT&T will not apply the Bill Statement Fee if any of the following apply:

- You receive your AT&T bill directly from AT&T via a paper bill or via an online bill.
- You qualify as a "low income" subscriber, defined as one who meets the eligibility requirements of a low income plan (e.g., lifeline, Link-Up, etc.) offered by the local telephone company. You must notify AT&T prior to February 18, 2005 of your eligibility and provide the AT&T required certification of eligibility to AT&T.
- You subscribe to AT&T Price Protection Plan, or AT&T One Rate<sup>®</sup> Basic plan, or AT&T One Rate Simple Plan.
- You inform AT&T that you are blind or visually impaired and have your telephone bill issued in Braille; or you are a customer in Missouri and you request your AT&T invoices in large print.
- Your local telephone company is AT&T.

The Bill Statement Fee is as specified in the Rate Schedule.

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## 50. AT&amp;T CORRECTIONAL VALUE PLAN\*

## 50.1 General

The AT&T Correctional Value Plan offers you a discount on eligible Collect calls received from inmates at correctional institutions that are subscribed to AT&T Prison Collect with Controls Service.

New and existing residential Customers presubscribed to AT&T as their primary interexchange carrier can enroll in this plan by completing and returning an enrollment form provided by AT&T, calling a designated AT&T 800 number, or by enrolling during a marketing contact with AT&T. Customers will receive the benefits of this plan until changed or canceled by AT&T.

This plan is offered in conjunction with the interstate AT&T Correctional Value Plan as specified in AT&T's Business Services Guide.

## 50.2 Rates and Charges

Eligible Calls include Collect Calls that originate from correctional institutions that are subscribed to AT&T Prison Collect with Controls and are billed to the customer's main residential telephone account.

Customers will pay a Monthly Recurring Charge applied from the interstate plan. AT&T will rate eligible calls at the AT&T Prison Collect with Controls Service rates. A 15% discount applies to the usage and service charges of the eligible calls.

The duration of a call that involves a fractional part of a minute will be rounded up to the next higher full minute. All other types of calls are rated at basic rates as specified in [Section A11.3.1](#) of AT&T's General Services tariff, unless the Customer is enrolled in another AT&T plan that covers these other types of calls.

## 50.3 Limitations

AT&T will discontinue a Customer's subscription to the plan when AT&T is notified that the Customer no longer subscribes to AT&T as their primary interexchange carrier. Discontinuance will be effective as of the date the Customer changed their primary interexchange carrier. In addition, the Customer upon written or verbal notice to AT&T may discontinue enrollment in this plan.

This plan is offered in conjunction with the AT&T interstate Plan and is only available to Customers where billing and technical capabilities exist and where AT&T provides and issues the bill.

\* AT&T Correctional Value Plan will no longer be available for enrollment to new Customers as of June 2, 2004.

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
