EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

The purpose of this filing is to comply with Commission Order No. PSC-04-0974-FOF-TP issued in Docket No. 030300-TP.

Description of Tariff

BellSouth is filing this tariff to comply with the requirement to establish a statewide average new service test rate for pay telephone providers.

Since the statewide average rate is less than all other payphone rates in A7, BellSouth will convert the entire customer base to the new statewide average rate. If a payphone provider wants to retain the old rate, the provider will need to contact BellSouth. Except for the rate, the payphone service for each convert line will not change.

Revenue Impact

The revenue impact for this filing is a decrease of \$344,696.
