Executive Summary

This tariff filing introduces the BellSouth® 2 Pack Plan.

The new package is available only to residence customers and contains a local exchange service access line and the following features:

- Caller ID - Deluxe
- Call Waiting Deluxe
- Call Forwarding Busy Line
- Call Forwarding Don't Answer
- Message Waiting Indication
- Star 98 Access

The package must contain the first two features and a residence customer may select any combination of the remaining features/services listed above. At any time a subscriber may add or remove any of the optional features/services to his/her personal 2 Pack Plan without paying an ordering charge.

The rate for the 2 Pack Plan is \$22.00 per month. This rate includes an access line that provides the standard flat rate calling area specified in A3.3.1 of the Tariff.

Introduction of the new plan will have no impact on existing customers. The package will be available for new orders going forward. Consequently, there will be no impact on the existing revenue stream from introduction of this new package.

The cost for the maximum bundle of features/services is less than the proposed rate for the plan.
