EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Description of Proposed Tariff

This Private Line Services Tariff filing increases the rates for certain Analog Private Line and SynchroNet Service rate elements.

Revenue Information

The following rate changes increases the Non-Basic Competitive basket by 0.74%, which is within the limits of AT&T Florida's price regulation plan.
