3T08 It's Your Number Promotion

Overview

The 3T08 It's Your Number Promotion promotion is scheduled to be extended beginning on 09/01/2008 and end on 12/31/2008. The It's Your Number(SM) Promotion (the"Program") will offer a discounts on the Subscriber's bill. The offer is only available to new AT&T subscribers requiring an Remote Call Forwarding ("RCF") to maintain their local exchange business number or existing AT&T subscribers that are moving within their local area that are required to change their business telephone number. Subscribers must have or subscribe to any local service agreement to participate in the program.

Promotion Specifics

The It's Your Number(SM) Promotion (the"Program") will offer a discounts on the Subscriber's bill. The offer is only available to new AT&T subscribers requiring an Remote Call Forwarding ("RCF") to maintain their local exchange business number or existing AT&T subscribers that are moving within their local area that are required to change their business telephone number. Subscribers must have or subscribe to any local service agreement to participate in the program.

Program Eligibility

- Available to new business customers requiring an RCF to maintain their local exchange business number; also existing customers that are moving within their local area that are required to change their business telephone number may participate.
- Subscriber must have or subscribe to any local service agreement to participate.
