J. SPECIAL PROMOTIONS (Cont'd)

eBill Promotion

During the period April 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009, business customers who receive their monthly invoices in paper format may be eligible for a one-time \$10 credit. To be eligible, customers who are contacted by the Company or who contact the Company and request this promotion must agree to begin receiving their monthly invoices electronically. The \$10 credit is limited to one credit per customer account, and will be reflected on the customer's invoice for the next full month's billing cycle.

Customers who agree to convert to electronic billing under this promotion will no longer receive copies of their invoices in paper format. This credit will not be rescinded for customers who subsequently request to convert from electronic to paper invoices.
