## **Executive Summary**

#### Introduction

This tariff filing introduces a new dialing restriction option for Customized Code Restriction service. The filing also makes minor updates to some existing options.

#### **Description of Service**

Some current dialing restriction options include the ability to block dialing that begins with 101XXXX to reach a certain type of long distance carrier, but the existing options also block other dialing arrangements.

This tariff filing adds a dialing restriction option that prohibits only dialing arrangements that begin with 101XXXX. The new option is available only to business customers.

Business customers who negotiate special long distance service rates with a carrier may benefit from special dialing arrangements that prohibit the placing of long distance calls via other carriers on a dial-around basis. Providing this capability in the telephone company switch is a logical solution for some customers.

The rate for the Prohibit 101XXXX Dialing option is \$1.50 per month. Normal service charges that apply for Customized Code Restriction also apply for Prohibit 101XXXX Dialing.

#### **Revenue Information**
