Executive Summary

Introduction

The purpose of this filing is to reduce the Transfer of Responsibility nonrecurring charge associated with MegaLink[®] Service, MegaLink[®] Channel Service and the MegaLink[®] Light Service located in Section B7 of the Private Line Services Tariff.

Description of the Tariff

The Transfer of Responsibility nonrecurring charge applies when the customer requests a change in ownership of MegaLink® facilities in association with a merger or acquisition. BellSouth will update its billing, maintenance and downstream systems to reflect the new customer of record information.

The Transfer of Responsibility nonrecurring charge is being reduced to respond to a market need. The reduced charge will encourage customers to initiate a customer of record change thereby allowing BellSouth's systems to reflect accurate customer record data.

The charge applies per channel and will be reduced from \$350 to \$50 for MegaLink[®] Service and MegaLink[®] Light Service and from \$374 to \$50 for MegaLink[®] Channel Service.

Revenue Impact

The filing reduces the revenue for the Transport Non-Basic basket by .0033%.
