

Thank you for informing us of your concerns regarding FPL's operation of its Turkey Point nuclear units. We too are concerned and are planning to conduct a thorough, in-depth review of the Turkey Point outages. Hearings are to be held on September 15, 1989. Industrial intervenors, who pay large electric bills due to the large amounts of electricity they consume, will participate in the investigation. Florida's Office of Public Counsel, representing citizens' groups such as yours, will also participate. A final decision on the matter is expected in February of 1990.

As you may know, the courts require us to have a documentable reason for disallowing fuel cost recovery for an electric utility. The fact that the unit experienced an unanticipated outage is insufficient. The Commission must find imprudence on the part of the company, in failing to prevent the outage, before we can disallow cost recovery.

I hope the above communicates to you that we are not taking FPL's pass- through of fuel costs lightly. We will be meticulous in our investigation. If all or a portion of replacement fuel costs are disallowed, customers will be given a refund of the fuel related charges they paid, including interest from the date of payment.

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

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
