ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING PASS-THROUGH RATE ADJUSTMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 27, 1988, Southeastern States Utilities, Inc. (Utility) notified this Commission of its intention to increase rates to its customers in Palm Beach County by application of the pass-through provisions of Subsection 367.081(4)(b), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.425, Florida Administrative Code.

The Utility intends to pass through to its customers the increased cost of purchased water imposed by the City of Pahokee effective February 1, 1989. The documentation submitted by the Utility in support of its notice meets the requirements set forth in Rule 25-30.425, Florida Administrative Code.

In compliance with Rule 25-30.425(6), Florida Administrative Code, the Utility advised us that it will provide notice to its customers prior to the effective date of the new rates, informing them of the impending rate adjustment and explaining that it is due to the application of the pass-through provisions of the statute.

The data presented in this application were based upon the twelve-month period ended November 1988. Our calculation of the pass-through adjustment is as follows:
