ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

Order No. 20610, issued January 17, 1989, was the final order in the above-referenced docket. That order directed that certain tariff provisions be filed by February 7, 1989.

On February 17, 1989, a request for extension of time to file the tariffs was filed by ALLTEL Florida, Inc., The Florala Telephone Company, Indiantown Telephone System, Inc., Northeast Florida Telephone Company, Inc. and Southland Telephone Company. In support of its request, the local exchange companies stated that they did not become aware of the provisions of Order No. 20610 until too late to make a timely filing; that they either did not receive a copy of Order No. 20610 or failed to see the directive to their company at page 7.

Upon consideration of the request, the companies will be given until March 31, 1989 to file tariffs reflecting the provisions required by Order No. 20610.

Therefore, based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Commissioner John T. Herndon, as Prehearing Officer, that the Request for Extension of Time to File Tariff filed by the companies identified in the body of this Order is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED that the companies identified herein shall file tariffs which comply with the requirements set forth in Order No. 20610 not later then the close of business March 31, 1989.
