# Statement of Basic Position:

The justification accepted by the Florida Public Service Commission when it first approved FPL's 500 kv transmission lines as an oil backout project pursuant to Rule 25-17.016, Florida Administrative Code, is no longer valid. Circumstances have changed such that the facts surrounding the transmission project are now outside the scope of the rule. The initial determination

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07552 JUL 27 1999 FPSC-RECORDS/REPORTING of qualification under the rule was not, and could not be, kinding for all future periods without regard to changed circumstances any more than a base rate proceeding conducted pursuant to relevant rules and statutes could be.

# Issues of Fact, Policy and Law:

The Citizens' adopt and support the issue identified and positions taken by the Florida Industrial Power Users Group on its Issues 1, 2 and 4-17. Additionally, the following issue is offered:

Issue: Is FPL amortizing its investment tax credits at the appropriate rate where it utilizes a company-wide composite rate instead of one specifically related to the oil backout project?

> <u>Public Counsel's Position</u>: FPL's use of a company-wide composite rate for amortization of ITCs associated with its oil backout project reduces the amortization of ITCs specifically associated with the project and increases the charges to customers.
