SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company
("Southern Bell" or "Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006,
Florida Administrative Code, and files its Request for Specified
Confidential Classification in the above-referenced docket. In
support of its Request, Southern Bell states as follows:

1. On February 16, 1990, the Commission issued Order No. 22567, in the above-referenced docket, which required Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company") to file traffic studies on four routes that are interLATA in nature. In response to the Commission's Order, Southern Bell is filing the traffic studies and is requesting that they be classified as proprietary confidential business information. In accord with Rule 25-22.006(4)(d), Florida Administrative Code, the information for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and is treated by

Southern Bell as private and has not been disclosed. The traffic studies are appended hereto in a sealed envelope as Attachment "A". The specific confidential information contained in the document has been highlighted so that it can be easily identified. Moreover, for the convenience of the parties of record, Southern Bell has removed the confidential information from the traffic studies and is providing the non-confidential version of the traffic studies to all parties of record as Attachment "B".

Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, requires 2. that confidential information be identified on a line-by-line Southern Bell requests that all the information highlighted be held confidential for the same reasons and therefore does not believe that a line-by-line identification is necessary in this instance. Nevertheless, in order to properly comply with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Southern Bell requests that the following specific information be held confidential: page 1, lines 1-4; page 2, lines 1-4; page 4, lines 1-28; page 5, lines 1-28; page 6, lines 1-28; page 7, lines 1-28; page 9, lines 1-4; page 10, lines 1-25; page 11, lines 1-25; page 12, lines 1-25; page 13, lines 1-25; page 14, lines 1-25; page 15, lines 1-25; page 16, lines 1-25; page 17, lines 1-25; page 18, lines 1-25; page 19, lines 1-25; page 20, lines 1-25; page 21, lines 1-25; page 22, lines 1-25; page 23, lines 1-25; page 24,

lines 1-25; page 25, lines 1-25; page 26, lines 1-4; page 27, lines 1-4; and page 28, lines 1-4.

- 3. In addition, Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, provides that a utility may satisfy its burden of proving that information is proprietary confidential business information by demonstrating how the information falls under one or more of the available statutory examples. In the alternative, if no statutory example is available, the utility may satisfy its burden by including a justifying statement indicating what penalties or ill effects it or its ratepayers will suffer from the disclosure of the information to the public.
- 4. The traffic studies relative to the interLATA routes at issue in this proceeding basically provide a blueprint of the toll usage over these routes. The information contained in the traffic studies was obtained from AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. ("AT&T") with the express understanding that such information was proprietary confidential business information and as such should be protected from public disclosure in these proceedings. The same information is normally made available to Southern Bell by AT&T on a confidential basis in order that Southern Bell may accurately plan its network deployment based on actual and perceived traffic demand over the relevant toll routes.
- 5. Although the traffic information is clearly necessary for a full examination of the merits of the extended area service

request in this case, such information also contains data that indicate the quantity of toll traffic over the East Orange to Mt. Dora route and the Orlando to Mt. Dora route. The disclosure of such traffic patterns to the public would make available to AT&T's competitors highly valuable competitive information which such competitors could use to determine whether or not to target this particular route.

- 6. If the Commission were to publicly release the interLATA traffic data Southern Bell has obtained from AT&T, not only would such public release competitively harm AT&T directly, but it also would almost certainly harm Southern Bell because AT&T might hereafter withhold such information from Southern Bell due to the threat of public release of such information. Without accurate traffic data from the interexchange carriers, Southern Bell would be severely hampered in its efforts to plan its needed network deployment, particularly with regard to situations where expansion may be needed. See, Order No. 22139, in Docket No. 881547-TL, and Order No. 22228, in Docket No. 890362-TL, in which the Commission held that similar traffic studies reflecting interLATA AT&T traffic were confidential.
- 7. For all the foregoing reasons, Southern Bell respectfully urges the Commission to classify the above-described and discussed interLATA traffic data as specified confidential business information pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative

Code, and as such exempt from Section 119.07, Florida Statutes. Due to the uncertainties involved in the viability of the particular toll routes at issue in the area covered by this request, no specific date can be determined when such information would become non-proprietary. Consequently, Southern Bell would urge that the Commission recognize that the information will remain proprietary confidential business information for as long as permitted by Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company moves the Prehearing Officer to enter his Order declaring this information to fall within the specified confidential classification.




