## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REBUTTAL AFFIDAVITS, TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS

By Motion filed June 15, 1990, St. Johns North Utility Corporation (SJN) has requested an extension of two weeks time, or until June 29, 1990, to file its rebuttal affidavits, testimony and exhibits in this proceeding because it has had difficulty locating attorneys from which it can obtain affidavits in rebuttal to those filed by General Development Utilities, Inc. (GDU) filed, on June 19, 1990, a response in opposition to SJN's Motion stating that this is an "example of the continuing pattern" of late filings that led to this award of attorneys' fees against SJN.

We are not well disposed toward this request by SJN. However, because this is the first time such a proceeding has been conducted by this Commission, we are very interested in giving both parties every opportunity to put forth their cases. For this reason, we will grant SJN until July 17, 1990, to file its rebuttal affidavits, testimony and exhibits. If such are not filed on that date, this matter will be expedited to an Agenda Conference for final disposition.

The prehearing statements will now be due July 25, 1990. No other dates require adjustment.

Based on the foregoing, it is, therefore,

ORDERED by Chairman Michael McK. Wilson, as Prehearing Officer, that St. Johns North Utility Corporation is hereby granted until July 17, 1990, to file its rebuttal affidavits, testimony and exhibits in this proceeding. In addition, the
