## ORDER ON PREHEARING PROCEDURE

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 25-22.038(3), Florida Administrative Code, Respondent is hereby required, to file with the Director of Records and Reporting a prehearing statement on or before August 24, 1990. The prehearing statement shall set forth the following:

- (a) all known witnesses that may be called and the subject matter of their testimony;
- (b) all known exhibits, their contents, and whether they may be identified on a composite basis and the witness sponsoring each;
- (c) a statement of basic position in the proceeding;
- (d) a statement of each question of fact the party considers at issue and which of the party's witnesses will address the issue;
- (e) a statement of each question of law the party considers at issue;
- (f) a statement of each policy question the party considers at issue and which of the party's witnesses will address the issue;
- (g) a statement of the party's position on each issue identified pursuant to paragraphs (d),(e) and (f) and the appropriate witness;
- (h) a statement of issues that have been stipulated to by the parties;

- (i) a statement of all pending motions or other matters the party seeks action upon; and
- (j) a statement as to any requirement set forth in this order that cannot be complied with, and the reasons therefor.

The original and fifteen copies of the prehearing statement must be received by the Director of Records and Reporting, 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0870, by the close of business on August 24, 1990. Prehearing statements shall substantially conform to the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure requirements as to form, signatures, and certificates.

In this docket the complainants are not represented by an attorney, and to require the complainants to prepare and prefile written testimony (as is customary before the Commission) would impose an undue hardship. Therefore, in lieu of prefiled testimony we will permit the filing of the June 27, 1990 depositions of complainants and their witnesses. These depositions may then be offered in evidence at the hearing in this docket in the same manner as prefiled testimony.

A prehearing conference will be held beginning at 9:30 a.m. on September 7, 1990 in Room 122, Fletcher Building, 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida. The final hearing in this docket will be held beginning at 10:00 a.m. on October 18, 1990.
