CONSUMMATING ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 23120, issued June 26, 1990, we proposed to approve a transfer of majority organizational control of Certificates Nos. 437-W and 368-S from Charles E. and Martha D. Barkley, and Sidney D. and Marcia Bronson, to Walter D. Medlin, subject to a petition for a formal proceeding in accordance with Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code. Our approval of the transfer was also conditioned upon Kings Point filing with this Commission a long-range utility plan, a copy of an application for a Department of Environmental Regulation wastewater construction permit, and a schedule of water system improvements, on or before September 24, 1990.

On July 12, 1990, the City of Kissimmee (City) filed a petition on Order No. 23120. The City did not request a formal hearing regarding this matter. Rather, it requested that we order Kings Point to serve copies of all of the above documents upon the City at the time that they are filed with this Commission. In light of the history of this utility, the City's request does not appears unreasonable. It is, therefore, granted.

Since there were no other petitions on Order No. 23120, it has become final and effective as of July 18, 1990.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. 23120 is hereby determined to be final and effective as of July 18, 1990, as provided in Rule 25-22.029(6), Florida Administrative Code. It is further

ORDERED that Kings Point Utilities shall serve copies of all long-range plans, permit applications, and improvement
