FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S RESPONSE AND OBJECTIONS TO NOTICE OF DEPOSITION DUCES TECUM

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") files its response and objections to Nassau Power Corporation's ("Nassau") Notice of Deposition Duces Tecum. Late in the day on November 27, 1990, Nassau sent by facsimile a notice of deposition duces tecum, noticing the November 30, 1990 deposition of S. S. Waters. The notice requested eighteen (18) categories of documents to be produced in three (3) different dockets. This is FPL's response and objections to Nassau's document request:

#### GENERAL OBJECTIONS

FPL objects to the broad "all documents" requests as being unnecessarily onerous and burdensome in the time allowed for production. Although counsel provided advance oral notice of the scheduling of the deposition, no oral notice of the scope of the

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documents to be requested was given. FPL has undertaken to provide materials that are responsive to the requests made, but objects to having to produce all documents (which would include all copies) that are potentially responsive on the ground of undue burden.

several of the document requests would include the production of materials supplied to FPL by Energy Management Associates ("EMA") which are proprietary to EMA. In particular, several request include PROSCREEN runs. Each of these runs has some formatted inputs that EMA maintains is proprietary and FPL has an obligation not to disclose. FPL will provide the parts of PROSCREEN runs which are not proprietary, but objects to providing the formatted inputs. With more time the runs could have been rerun to purge the proprietary information, but sufficient time is no longer reasonably available.

### SPECIFIC RESPONSES AND OBJECTIONS
