ORDER GRANTING AMENDMENT AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

Background

On November 11, 1990, Poinciana Utilities, Inc. (Poinciana or Utility) filed an application with this Commission to amend Certificates Nos. 146-W and 103-S in Osceola County to include territory in Polk county, pursuant to Section 367.171(7), Florida Statutes. The Utility serves approximately 1,127 customers in Polk County pursuant to an ordinance granted by the County. Poinciana also serves approximately 2,984 water customers and 2,803 wastewater customers in Osceola County.

Application

The application is in compliance with Section 367.171, Florida Statutes, and other pertinent statutes and administrative rules. In particular, the application contains:

- A filing fee in the amount of \$4,500, as prescribed by Section 167.171, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code.
- Territory and system maps and a territory description, pursuant to Section 367.171, Florida Statutes. The Utility also provided copies of the franchise agreements with Polk County. The territory in Polk County is described in Attachment A of this Order.
- Evidence that the Utility owns the land upon which its facilities are located.

Since this is a grandfather application, noticing of the application is not required.

Poinciana is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Avatar Utilities, Inc., and has been providing service in the area for almost 20 years. Poinciana has consistently demonstrated its financial and technical ability to provide safe and reliable service to its customers. In addition, the Department of Environmental Regulation has no outstanding citations for this system. Therefore, we find that it is in the public interest to amend Certificates Nos. 146-W and 103-S to include the territory described in Attachment A of this Order. Poinciana is directed to return the Certificates to this Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for entry reflecting the additional territory. The Utility has filed revised tariff sheets reflecting the territory in Polk County. The tariff sheets will be approved upon issuance of this Order.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900 (a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
