I am writing you once again to request prompt rulings on pending motions before the Commission in this docket.

When I wrote you on July 18, 1991, a Southern Bell motion for confidential treatment and permanent protective order had been ripe for a decision for 10 days. Now it has been ripe for 22 days. Until the Prehearing Officer rules, the documents that are the subject of the motion remain confidential without any review of the validity of Southern Bell's request.

In addition, our office filed a motion to compel on July 11, 1991, and Southern Bell filed its response on July 18, 1991. That matter has been ripe for decision since July 18, 1991. We need a prompt ruling in order to properly continue our investigation in this docket.
