Dear Mr. Tribble;

It was my understanding from you that the matter before the PSC would be reviewed by the full Commission. As was required, I filed a Motion, mailed it Certified, and received Notice of its Receipt, by Albert Johnson, on July 3, in the AM.

This Motion was scheduled by the PSC to be received no later than 5 pm of July 2. However, your office did not promptly mail this Notice which fore-shortened my time to prepare by several days.

On July 3, 1991 a letter was mailed to me, signed by Kay Flynn stating that "...the order was not protested, and the docket has been closed". Docket No. 910486-TL, Complaint of GHF Associates against Southern Bell Telephone.

In the one hand Ms Flynn was signing a letter dismissing the matter because no complaint had been received when in fact in her other hand she should have had the complaint mentioned.

On July 12, 1991 I mailed a MOTION TO MOVE PETITION OUT OF TIME. On August 26, 1991 I was mailed your Order # 24971, re: Docket 910486-TL referring to your Order No. 24654, issued June 11, 1991 stating that the Petition for Formal Proceeding as denied due to its untimely filing and further stated that I"failed to show any good cause for granting his request late filing of his Petition for Formal Proceeding."

I find it inconceivable that either the matter of timely filing, or the showing of good cause were insufficient. To make this judgement would be to completely avoid the clear statements made in my petition and to foreclose my option to receive a full and fair hearing. I await your efforts, Mr. Tribble, to correct this inequity.
