Dear Mr. Gray:

I received your letter dated September 9, 1991 and am writing primarily to inform you that your objection to the Commission's latest action denying your Motion to Move Petition Out of Time is being scheduled for their consideration at our October 15, 1991 conference.

I must tell you, however, that I can see no inequity in the manner in which we have handled your complaint. The orders of this Commission are very clear as to the time frames and procedures available to affected parties who may wish to protest a proposed action, file a petition for reconsideration or appeal a decision to the courts. The initial Notice of Proposed Agency Action was mailed to you in a timely manner and should have allowed you more than the required 14 days in which to respond. You did not respond within the allotted time. Our order denying your Motion to Move Petition Out of Time provided that a petition for reconsideration could be filed within 15 days of its issuance. You did not file a petition for reconsideration.

I cannot speak to the merits of your case, but from a procedural viewpoint I believe you have been dealt with fairly.
