## Dear Edith:

In follow up to our conversation earlier this week, I wanted to clarify the issue with regard to water deposits. As I have mentioned earlier, we intend to reduce the rent to our residents an amount equivalent to the prevailing water and sewer allowance that is established in each location i.e., the Jacksonville allowance is \$27.00 per household, per month. As we shift the responsibility for water and sewer over to the resident, we intend to reduce their rent by the \$27.00 allowance. In order to insure good faith participation by the resident for this reduction in rent, we are increasing the security deposit by \$50.00, which still keeps cur total security deposit within about 50% of their monthly rent. This total amount should be adequate to hopefully cover any damages and that are unpaid when the resident vacates his or her apartment.
