RULE TITLE:

RULE NO.: 25-9.053

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The rule is being amended to include the Commission's present practice of evaluating rate structure changes for municipal and cooperative electric utilities based on cost data from comparably situated public utilities.

SUMMARY: In the absence of actual cost and operating data from a municipal or cooperative electric utility which requests a rate structure change, Commission staff will evaluate the proposed changes on the basis of data from comparably situated public electric utilities which share characteristics similar to the municipal or cooperative electric utility. The municipal and cooperative utilities will no longer be required to submit a tabulation of changes.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY: 366.05(1), F.S.

LAW IMPLEMENTED: 366.04(2)(b), F.S.

SUMMARY OF THE ESTIMATE OF ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THIS RULE:

The amendments should not increase costs or paperwork to the Commission or to the affected utilities. Some utilities may experience a savings by not tabulating charges and not submitting actual cost and operating data.

25-9.053 <u>Filing and Evaluation of Information to Accompany</u> Submittals.

(1) Each letter transmitting a utility's proposed documentation in which any change in rate structure is proposed shall be accompanied by the following items in connection with each new and existing service classification:

(1) As applicable a tabulation setting forth, at appropriate consumption levels, the charges applicable under the present and proposed rate together with the difference expressed in dollars and in percent; and

(2)—<u>S</u>supporting information in sufficient detail as to allow the Commission to determine the derivation of all rate structure modifications. All additional relevant information deemed necessary by the Commission shall be submitted in addition to the

above upon request.

(2) The utility may submit actual cost and operating data to support its proposed change in rate structure. If the utility does not submit actual cost and operating data, the Commission shall evaluate the proposed change in rate structure on the basis of cost and operating data from one or more comparably situated public electric utilities which the Commission determines to be most similar to the filing utility. Data from the comparable utilities shall be considered in conjunction with all submitted information which is specific to the filing utility.
