AMENDATORY ORDER

By Order No. PSC-93-0419-FOF-WS, issued March 18, 1993, the Commission approved rates and charges for W.P. Utilities, Inc., by proposed agency action. Pages 9 and 10 of that Order contain clerical errors. The second column of the quarterly rates comparisons on those pages should have the heading "Commission Calculated Non-compensatory Rates," not "Utility Requested." The utility's requested rates are the same as the Commission approved rates which appear in the fourth column. The rates in the second column are non-compensatory rates which the Commission calculated without adjusting the utility's proposed exclusion of depreciation expense and rate of return and without adjusting the billing analysis. The rates in the third column are the Commission's calculated fully compensatory rates. Accordingly, the columns on pages 9 and 10 of the Order are hereby clarified as follows.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that

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is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

The action proposed in Order No. PSC-92-0419-FOF-WS, issued March 18, 1993, was preliminary in nature and would not become effective or final, except as provided by Rule 25-22.029. Florida Administrative Code. The content of this Order amends Order No. PSC-92-0419-FOF-WS. Therefore, the issuance of this Order extends the protest period provided in Order No. PSC-92-0419-FOF-WS. Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the action proposed in Order No. PSC-92-0419-FOF-WS, as amended, may file a petition for a formal proceeding, as provided by Rule 25-22.029(4), Florida Administrative Code, in the form provided by Rule 25-22.036(7)(a) and (f), Florida Administrative Code. This petition must be received by the Director, Division of Records and Reporting at his office at 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0870, by the close of business on April 14, 1993.

In the absence of such a petition, Order No. PSC-92-0419-FOF-WS, as amended, shall become effective on the day subsequent to the above date as provided by Rule 25-22.029(6), Florida Administrative Code.

Any objection or protest filed in this docket before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.

If Order No. PSC-92-0419-FOF-WS, as amended, becomes final and effective on the date described above, any party adversely affected may request judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or by the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
