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

NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BST") d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), and files its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

1.

The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") has issued several Audit Requests in the referenced docket in connection with the NARUC/FCC Regional Audit of BellSouth. The Staff has requested, among other things, that Southern Bell make available for viewing the following information:

(a) Audit Request No. 2-056, dated April 14, 1993 - description of all allocation methodologies used by BellCore to charge costs to projects and to charge common costs to BOCs in 1992.

Some of the information to be provided regarding BellCore's methodologies and procedures is proprietary confidential business information under the terms of Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes. Disclosure of this information would harm BellCore's business operations, and since BellCore is owned in part by BST, it would harm BST's ratepayers. In addition, it would disclose

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information concerning the other owners, which consist of the other six regional Bell holding companies. Finally, this information is akin to other states information which the Commission in a previous order has indicated would be treated as unregulated, and thus confidential material.

Because this information contains proprietary information, Southern Bell is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(b)(5), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Staff to review this information without delay. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information. The written Staff Request is attached hereto.
