LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Wootens

Combined Service Territory:

POINT OF BEGINNING being in Section 41, Township 13 South, Range 26 East, Putnam County, Florida, at the corner where the Westerly right-of-way of County Road 309 and the Southerly right-of-way of Brown's Fish Camp Road, also known as Sunset Drive intersect, thence running 2,250 feet more or less in the Northwesterly direction up to the water's edge of the St. John's River, thence 1,700 feet more or less following the water's edge of the St. John's River in the Southwesterly direction up to the Southwestern corner of Section 41, thence running 3,350 feet more or less along the South line of Section 41 up to the Southwesterly right-of-way of County Road 309, thence continue running 2,000 feet more or less in the Northwesterly direction along the right-of-way of County Road 309 to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
