Pursuant to Section 367.045 , Florida Statutes, South Seas Utility Company (South Seas), by and through its undersigned counsel, files this application for extension of service area (amendment of Certificate 268-S) in Lee County, Florida, and in accordance with Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code, hereby supplies the following information:

1. a) The name and address of the utility is:

b) South Seas has the financial and technical ability to provide service to the proposed extension. Financial information concerning South Seas is on file with the Commission in the 1992 Annual Report. Hydrologic Florida, Inc., under this name and previous names, has operated the plant since 1977. There is a need for service to the proposed extension. Please see the attached letter dated June 15, 1993 from McCarthy's Marina, Inc.

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07379 \text { UUL -98 }
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(Exhibit A) By including these parcels in the service area, existing septic systems will be removed and the need to expand these systems to accommodate redevelopment will be eliminated. Further, the marina pump-out station will provide a much needed facility for the recreational boat traffic in the Pine Island Sound Aquatic Preserve.

There are no other utilities within a four-mile radius which could potentially provide service to the proposed extension.
c) The provision of service to the extended area is consistent with the wastewater section of the local comprehensive plan, as approved by the Department of Community Affairs.
d) South Seas owns the land upon which the utility treatment facilities that will serve the proposed territory are located. Copies of a May 6, 1980 Warranty Deed, and a May 27, 1986 quit claim deed prepared to correct certain technicalities in the legal description, are attached. (Exhibit B)
e) A description of the territory proposed to be served, using township, range and section references, is attached. (Exhibit C)
f) A detailed system map showing the proposed lines, treatment facilities and the territory proposed to be served is attached. (Exhibit D)
g) South Seas has the capacity in its existing lines and its 450,000 gallons per day (GPD) treatment facility to serve this small proposed expansion. The proposed lift station and force
main are sized to serve only the property that is specified in this application.
h) The existing primary method of effluent disposal is by spray irrigation.
i) A copy of the official county tax assessment map with the proposed territory plotted thereon is attached. (Exhibit E)
j) The proposed expansion will consist of a lift station and a $6^{\prime \prime}$ force main discharging into an existing lift station. The proposed extension and lift stations with their connecting lines will adequately handle the estimated additional flow of 10,300 GPD.

When the existing treatment plant was expanded in 1989 from 300,000 to $450,000 \mathrm{GPD}$, the engineering calculation indicated that the certificated service area, at build out, would require a 384,400 GPD treatment and disposal facility. To this was added 15\%, or 57,660 GPD, for reserve capacity, resulting in a design criteria of 442,060 GPD. The plant was actually expanded to 450,000 GPD.

The certificated service area was approximately $95 \%$ built out by 1990. The monthly operating reports submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation (FDER) by the plant operator for the past $31 / 2$ years show the average daily flow to be 237,000 GPD. The maximum daily flow tops 400,000 GPD on occasion, but has never exceeded the design capacity of the treatment facility.
k) No FDER permits for the proposed extension have been applied for at this time. Upon Commission approval of this application, South Seas will sign and the developer will file the appropriate permit applications.

1) The cost of construction of the proposed lift station and force main is estimated at $\$ 86,600$. It is undetermined at this time whether the developer will remit $\$ 51,000$ in service availability charges, with the balance funded as utility investment, or whether the developer will construct and contribute the proposed lift station and force main. This will be determined after rezoning and permitting necessary for the project are resolved. In any event, there will be no significant impact on South Seas' capital structure.
$\mathrm{m})$ The usage of the subject parcel will include overnight accommodations, a swimming pool, a small retail and food and beverage operation and overnight marina facilities including a pump-out station. This will produce an estimated flow of 10,300 GPD or 34 ERC's.
n) The proposed extension will have no impact on South Seas' monthly rates and service availability charges. The present rates and charges will apply.
o) Second Revised Sheet No. 3.3, reflecting the additional service area, is attached. (Exhibit F) Commission Staff accepted the legal description set forth in the notices for notice purposes only, and indicated that for final approval the legal description set forth in the tariff would need to be restated with
a point of beginning referenced from either a section corner or a subsection corner. The attached proposed tariff sheet restates the legal description accordingly.
p) Certificate 268-S is attached. (Exhibit G)
2. The proposed extension would provide less than 999 persons with wastewater service. Pursuant to Rule $25-30.020$, Florida Administrative Code, the filing fee for the application is $\$ 150$. A check in that amount payable to the Commission accompanies this application.
3. a) Pursuant to Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, South Seas obtained from the Commission a list of municipalities, other government authorities, and wastewater utilities within a four-mile radius of the territory proposed to be added. (Exhibit H)
b) On July 8, 1993, South Seas provided a copy of the Notice by certified mail to the governmental authorities and neighboring utilities required under Rule 25-30.030(5)(a) through (f), Florida Administrative Code. South Seas also provided a copy of the l'otice by certified mail to the City of Sanibel and Sanibel Sewer Systems, although they were not reflected on the four-mile list provided by the Commission. An affidavit of Wayne L. Schiefelbein confirming this provision of notice, together with a copy of the Notice, is attached. (Exhibit I)
c) On July 8, 1993, South Seas provided a copy of the Notice by requiar mail to each customer to be served by the proposed extension, pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(6), Florida

Administrative Code. An affidavit confirming this provision of notice is attached. (Exhibit J)
d) Arrangements have been made with the Fort Myers News-Press, a newspaper of general circulation in the territory proposed to be added, to publish the Notice once a week for three consecutive weeks. The first publication was made July 1, 1993. Upon completion of the three publications, South Seas will file proof of publication.
4. South Seas' existing rates are a result of a pass-through rate adjustment effective November 8, 1991. Order No. 22094 (October 26,1989 ) is the most recent order of the Commission establishing or amending the wastewater rates and charges for South Seas.
5. An affidavit that South Seas has a tariff and annual reports on file with the Commission is attached. (Exhibit K)

Based on the foregoing, South Seas requests that Certificate 268-S be amended to extend its authorized service territory.

Following up on my recent phone inquiry, I am writing this letter to formalize a request for sewer service.

The property to be served includes four (4) parcels on Captiva Island, located at the northeast, intersection of Captiva Drive S.W. and Andy Rose Lane (formerly Palm Avenue). I am making this request on behalf of McCarthy's Marina, Inc. as the owner of Parcels $A, B$ and $C$, and contract purchaser of Parcel $D$, all as shown on the attached sketch. A legal description of the combined parcels is also enclosed for your information.

McCarthy's Marina, Inc. is currently operating rental cottages, commercial retail facitlities, and a commercial marina.
