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Southern States Utilities, Inc. (SSU or Utility) provides water and wastewater service in 27 counties throughout the State of Florida. The annual report for 1992 indicates that the operating revenue for water is \$19,042,175 and wastewater \$9,370,486. The net operating income for water is \$2,979,619 and for wastewater is (\$611,642). The Utility is a Class A utility company under FPSC jurisdiction.

On April 29, 1993, the utility applied for an amendment to Water Certificate Nos. 76-W and 284-S in Putnam County, Florida. The proposed extensions are to the utility's six current water and wastewater systems in Putnam County, Beecher's Point, Interlachen Lake Estates, Palm Port, River Park, Saratoga Harbor and Wootens. An objection was received for SSU's amendment to its Water Certificate No. 76-W in Putnam County. Mrs. James Swayze formally withdrew her objection to SSU's amendment by a letter addressed to the Commission on July 19, 1993.

The proposed territories are immediately adjacent to the utility's existing territory in Putnam County. SSU is currently serving customers in the proposed amendment areas. SSU is currently in compliance with Order No. PSC-93-0202-FOF-WS, issued on February 9, 1993. That order approved SSU's schedule for submitting amendment applications.

SSU's proposed amendments are in a critical use area as defined by the St. Johns River Water Management District. The six developments have small water plants which provide water service to customers in Putnam County. Additionally, the Palm Port system provides wastewater serve to customers in the Palm Port development. The Palm Port wastewater plant capacity is 50,000 gallons per day. Currently, the wastewater system is not sized to provide reclaimed water, however should the utiliary flows reach

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100,000 gallons per day, reuse requirement should then be addressed. The amendment is consistent with Putnam County Comprehensive Plan and there will be no additional water or wastewater facilities built to serve the proposed territory. Service will be provide by extending existing transmission and distribution lines.

The application is in compliance with the governing statute, Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and other pertinent statutes and administrative rules concerning an application for amendment of certificate. The application contains a check in the amount of \$300.00 which is the correct filing fee pursuant to Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code. The applicant has provided evidence that the utility owns the land upon which the utility's facilities are located as required by Rule 25-30.036(1)(d), Florida Administrative Code in the form of a warranty deed.

Adequate service territory and system maps and a torritory description have been provided as prescribed by Rule 25-30.036(1)(e),(f) and (i), Florida Administrative Code. A description of the territory requested by the utility is appended to this memorandum as Attachment A. The utility has submitted an affidavit consistent with Section 367.045(2)(d), Florida Statutes, that it has tariffs and annual reports on file with the Commission.

In addition, the application contains proof of compliance with the noticing provisions set forth in Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. The one objection that was received has been withdrawn and the time for filing such objection has expired.

Presently, SSU provides quality water and wastewater service to the residents of Putnam County. The utility has the capability and financial resources to adequately service the proposed new territory. The proposed new territory will have no substantial effect on the utility's financial status. SSU currently has no outstanding violation reported by the Department of Environmental Regulation.

The utility's approved water and wastewater rates were effective September 18,1992, pursuant to Order No. PSC-92-0948-FOF-SU, issued in Docket No. 920199-WS, a rate case docket. The utility has indicated that the proposed amendment will have no significant impact on its existing rates and charges. Staff recommends that these rates and charges be applied to customers in the new service territory.

The utility has filed revised tariff sheets incorporating the additional territory into its tariff and has submitted Certificates

Nos. 76-W and 284-S for entry reflecting the additional territory. Based on the above information, staff believes it is in the public interest to grant the application of Southern States Utilities, Inc. for amendment of Water Certificate No. 76-W and Wastewater Certificate No. 284-S for the territory described in Attachment A and B. An administrative order should be issued approving the application.

POINT OF BEGINNING being at the Southwest corner of Section 40, Township 9 South, Range 27 East, Putnam County, Florida, where Cow's Creek forms, thence running 1,600 feet more or less along the North side of Cow's Creek in the Easterly direction to the Westerly right-of-way of East River Drive, thence 1,840 feet more or less in the Northwesterly direction along said right-of-way to the Northerly right-of-way of Cypress Drive, thence running 1,700 feet more or less in the Westerly direction to the water's edge of the St. John's River, thence following the water's edge of said river in the Southerly direction for 2,200 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
