- 1. Rule 25-22.058(1), Florida Administrative Code, provides that any request for oral argument "shall state with particularity why oral argument would aid the Commission in comprehending and calculating the issues before it." [Emphasis supplied].
- 2. Citrus County's Request for Oral Argument on its Response in Opposition to Southern States' Motion to Vacate Automatic Stay and Motion for Reduced Interim Rates Pending Judicial Review, for Recalculated Customer Bills, Refunds and Imposition of Penalties for Violating Automatic Stay contains no explanation as to why oral argument would aid the Commission in comprehending and evaluating the issues addressed in the motions and responses pending before the Commission in this docket.
- 3. Citrus County's Request for Oral Argument fails to comply with the mandatory requirements of Rule 25-22.058(1), Florida Administrative Code, and must be denied.
