Those documents for which confidentiality rulings are pending are being processed expeditiously to accommodate your request. For Mr. Poucher: 1759-93, 214 of 310 pages are subject to requests for confidentiality; 12871-93, 104 of 495 pages are subject to requests for confidentiality; 12865-93, 60 of 147 pages are subject to requests for confidentiality. For Mr. Reid: 1894-93, 13239-93, 108-94, 44 out of approximately 1,000 pages are subject to requests for confidentiality. Our good faith estimate is that the rulings will be completed by February 10, 1994.

Regarding your request relating to testimony of Mr. Earl Poucher, there are some documents that have been returned to the Office of Public Counsel. Specifically, Document No. 13458-92 and cross referenced Document No. 1409-93 were in returned July, 1993. These documents are original versions of testimony that were rendered stale by the rescheduling of the hearings to the following year. In addition, Document Numbers 12062-93, 12874-93 and 13255-93 have been returned.



Mr. Deason:

This is a request for public documents under Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes. We are asking for the release of particular documents filed in the Southern Bell rate case, 92-0260.

We are requesting the following records:



-- All testimony from Tim Devlin. 13427-93


