PETITION FOR INTERIM RELIEF

Applicant, NORTH FORT MYERS UTILITY, INC., ("NFMU"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, files this Petition to allow it to interconnect with the Carriage Village Landowner's Association, Inc. ("Carriage Village") wastewater collection system during the pendency of this proceeding and to collect is rates and charges, subject to refund, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Carriage Village is an association-owned mobile home community in North Fort Myers, Florida, which provides wastewater service to its members, and 45 lots in the Royal Coach mobile home community pursuant to PSC Certificate 057-S.
- 2. Ninety-Five Percent (95%) of the shareholders of Carriage Village voted to enter into an agreement with NFMU to interconnect

with NFMU and to transfer to NFMU its collection system so that it could abandon its wastewater treatment and disposal facilities.

- 3. One letter, which was signed by four customers, was received by the PSC questioning the interconnection. The Staff is now inquiring of those customers as to whether they formally object to the transfer, and a decision is expected by March 1, 1994.
- 4. Carriage Village is in immediate need to abandon its wastewater treatment and disposal system. The PSC is not scheduled to take proposed agency action on this proceeding until its June 21, 1994 agenda conference.
- 5. Not allowing the immediate interconnection will potentially subject Carriage Village to fines by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.
- 6. The customers will not be prejudiced by granting the interconnection and paying NFMU's rates and charges since the rates and charges will be subject to refund.
