Issue 3: Recommendation that the rates and charges contained in North Fort Myers Utility, Inc.'s tariff on file with the Commission should be applied to service provided in the additional territory. If a protest is timely filed, NFMU should be authorized to charge its authorized rates subject to refund with interest. NFMU should also be required to provide a bond, a letter of credit, or an escrow account in the amount of \$442,906 as security in the event that a refund becomes necessary, and should be required to comply with Rule 25-30.360(6), F.A.C., regarding reporting of funds subject to refund and status of the security being provided.

<u>Issue 4:</u> Recommendation that rate base should not be established for Carriage Village Landowners' Association at this time.

Issue 5: Recommendation that the Commission deny Forth Fort Myers Utility's (NFMU) Petition for Interim Relief, filed February 16, 1994. The issue is moot.

Issue 6: Recommendation that this docket be closed if no protest is timely filed to the Commission's notice of proposed agency action for Issues Nos. 3 and 4.
