<u>Issue 3:</u> Recommendation that the interim rates for St. George Island Utility Company should be designed to produce revenues of \$348,824 for water using the base facility charge rate structure. The approved rates will be effective for service rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets pursuant to 25-30.475(1), F.A.C. The rates may not be implemented until proper notice has been received by the customers. The utility should provide proof of the date the notice was given no less than 10 days after the date of the notice.

<u>Issue 4:</u> Recommendation that the utility should be required to file a bond, letter of credit or escrow agreement to guarantee any potential refunds of water revenues collected under interim conditions. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.360(7), F.A.C., the utility shall provide a report by the 20th of each month indicating the monthly and total revenue collected subject to refund.
