## SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S MOTION TO STRIKE RESPONSE BY TIME WARMER AND OF FLORIDA, L.P.

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), hereby respectfully requests, pursuant to Rule 25-22.037(2)(a), the entry of an order striking the Response by Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. to Florida Cable Television Association's Motion for Reconsideration and/or Clarification of Order No. PSC-94-0285-FOF-TP, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

- 1. Rule 25-22.037(2)(b) provides that "other parties to a proceeding, may, within seven (7) days after service of a written motion, file written memoranda in opposition". Beyond this, there is no provision in the Rules of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") that authorizes a response to a motion.
- 2. Nevertheless, Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. ("Time Warner"), filed on April 6, 1994 what it called a "Response by Tine Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. to Florida Cable Television Association's Motion for Reconsideration and/or Clarification of Order No. PSC-94-0285-FOF-TP ("Response"). This pleading, however, is not a memorandum in opposition to the motion of the Florida Cable Television Association ("FCTA"). Instead, Time

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Warner states that it concurs with the Motion for Reconsideration of FCTA then goes on to attempt to buttress the legal argument of FCTA.

. . . .

This type of concurring pleading is not authorized by this Commission's rules or by the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure. Time Warner is simply abusing the rules of this Commission by arguing for reconsideration without filing a timely motion for that purpose. Accordingly, this unauthorized "response" should be stricken.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company respectfully requests the entry of an Order striking the Response by Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. to Florida Cable Television Association's Motion for Reconsideration and/or Clarification of Order No. PSC-94-0285-FOF-TP, for the reasons set forth above.
