# AMENDED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TRAFFIC STUDY

United Telephone Company of Florida (United) files this Amended Motion for Extension of Time (the added and changed portions of the original Motion are underlined in this Amended Motion) and moves the Florida Public Service Commission to grant United an extension of time to file its traffic studies in this Docket, and as grounds therefore states:

- 1. Florida Public Service Commission Order No. PSC-94-0091-PCO-TL was issued in this Docket on January 26, 1994, and requires traffic studies be submitted by United and other local exchange companies. The Order specified that the traffic studies should be studies which cover a minimum of thirty days of representative calling patterns and should begin no sooner than February 1, 1994 and conclude no later than March 31, 1994. The Order directed that such studies be filed within ninety days of the date of the Order.
- 2. United's traffic study system was established to provide traffic studies for study periods within any given calendar month. The system is not designed to provide accurate analysis for a period spanning more than one calendar month. Given the limitation of the system, United could perform the traffic studies required for the month of February 1994 or the month of March 1994. The Order was issued on January 26, 1994, which gave insufficient time

to set up the studies for the month of February 1994, so the month of March 1994 was selected

as the study month.

3. The due date for the studies is April 26, 1994. Twenty-six days from the end of the

study period is not sufficient time for United to provide complete and accurate studies for the

routes served by United. United estimates it will take approximately sixty days from the close

of the study period to provide complete and accurate studies of the routes served by United.

4. United is also currently undertaking a major upgrade of its message accounting

system. As a part of this upgrade United is replacing its toll processing and control system.
