PE: DOCKET NO. 940352-WU: REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATION FOR A WATER TREATMENT SYSTEM IN NASSAU COUNTY BY OXEFENOKE RURAL ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION.

Okefenoke Rural Electric Membership Corporation (Okefenoke) filed an application as a nonjurisdictional entity pursuant to Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes, on April 7, 1994. The physical address of the system is S.W. Ouadrant, Co. Road 115 and Henry Smith Road, and the Mailing address is P.O. Box 1229, Hilliard, Florida 32046. The address on the primary contact person, Mr. Gary Strickland, is P.O. Box 602, Nahunta, Georgia 31553, (912) 462-5131, The applicant indicates that it provides water service to customers of Okefenoke only, and there is no charge for providing this service. The cost of these services are recovered as an operational expense. The lot is equiped with a septic tank.

The application was filed in accordance with Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.060(3)(j), Florida CAF Administrative Code. The application also contains a signed statement acknowledging that the applicant is aware of the requirements of Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, regarding making a false statement.

Therefore, based on the information submitted by the utility,

staff recommends that the system meets the requirements for
exemption under Section 367.021(12), as a non-jurisdictional
system. An administrative order should be issued within thirty
days approving Okefenoke's application for exemption pursuant to
Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes, and closing the docket.

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
