I am writing in connection with the above entitled application for P.S.C. approval of a wastewater treatment plant.

I do not understand how the application can even be acted upon, since, under the rules of the Commission, it is incomplete.

Under 25-30.033 (r), the applicant is to file "a detailed financial statement..." The applicant has submitted no such financial statement. A December 31, 1993 balance sheet was submitted as Exhibit G, showing as an asset, land of the value of one hundred and seventeen thousand dollars (\$117,000).

Resort Village Utility, Inc. was formed on October 5, 1993, and as far as I am able to determine, owned no land whatsoever on December 31, 1993

In addition, 25-30.033 (1) (s) requires "a list of all entities upon which the applicant is relying to provide funding....which shall include their financial statements..." The only attempt to fulfill this requirement is Exhibit 1 which merely states that one Dr, Johnson and Coastal Development Consultants, Inc. will provide the funding.

The other requirements of 25-30.033 also remain unmet.


