COMES NOW Locals 3121, 3122 and 3107 Communication Workers of America, AFL-CIO ("CWA"), by and through their undersigned counsel, and files this Second Motion for Clarification and states:

On September 2, 1994, CWA filed a Motion to Reset Hearing 1. and Motion for Clarification. As of this date, the PSC has not responded to this Motion.

On or about November 28, 1994 the undersigned counsel 2. contacted Tracy Hatch who confirmed that an Order would be served on the parties resolving all previous Motions on discovery and other matters within a week to ten days. As of this date, no order has been entered by the PSC.

There are several outstanding motions pertaining to 3. discovery and other matters including CWA's Motion to Appear by Telephone for which a decision has not yet been rendered.
