WS 941044-SO; RESOLUTION OF BOARD NO. COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY DECLARING CHARLOTTE COUNTY SUBJECT TO PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 367, F.S.-REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FOR PROVISION OF WASTEWATER SERVICE BY EDGEWATER MANOR ASSOCIATION INC.

In accordance with Chapter 367.031, Florida Statutes (F.S.), "Each utility subject to the jurisdiction of the commission must obtain from the commission a certificate of authorization to provide w ter or wastewater service or an order recognizing that the system is exempt from regulation as provides by s. 367.022. On November 11, 1994, Edgewater Manor Association, Inc. (Edgewater Manor or applicant), applied for an exemption for a wastewater facility from the Florida Public Service Commission under Section 367.022 (6), F.S., a small system exemption. The applicant's physical address and mailing address is 22333 Edgewater Drive D-4, Charlotte Harbor, Florida, 33980. Mr. Joseph Pilkington is the president and primary contact person. Mr. Pilkington's mailing address is the same as referenced above.

Wastewater service will be provided solely to Edgewater Manor Condominium Association. Water service is provided by Port Charlotte Utility. Edgewater Manor provided a copy of the Department of Environment Protection's (DEP) operation permit. The DEP letter of authorization stated that the applicant's wastewater treatment system is capable of handling 10,000 GPD (gallons per day), which is the average daily flow). Edgewater Manor stated, in the application, that its wastewater treatment system has the CIR . capacity to serve one hundred (100) or fewer persons as defined in Rule 25-30.053, Florida Administrative Code. In addition, the applicant acknowledged Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, regarding false statements. Lill DPC -

Based upon the facts presented herein, staff believes of Edgewater Manor Association, Inc.'s wastewater system is exempt as of Edgewater Manor Association, F.S., and Rule 25-30.060(3)(f), defined by Section 367.022(6), F.S., and Rule 25-30.060(3)(f), Florida Administrative Code. Section 2.08(C)(14) of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM) gives '/AS ___ administrative authority to approve requests for determination of TH - exempt status that are clear-cut and without controversy. Since the applicant needs this exemption order to continue to obtain its
