## ORDER CONTINUING PROCEEDINGS

By Order Number PSC-94-0092-PCO-TC, issued January 26, 1994, and Order Number PSC-95-0016-PCO-TC, issued January 5, 1995, the procedural schedule for this proceeding was established and this matter was set for hearing on February 14, 1995.
