2	(Hearing convened at 1:35 p.m.)
3	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Call the prehearing
4	conference to order.
5	First of all, let me apologize for the slight
6	delay and the fact that we're meeting in a different
7	room; but as I'm sure everyone is aware, the internal
8	affairs that we had scheduled for today proceeded longer
9	than we first envisioned. And with that, we'll begin
10	with having the notice read.
11	MS. BROWN: By notice issued February 10th,
12	1995, this time and place was set for a prehearing
13	conference in the following dockets: Docket
14	No. 950001-EI, Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery
15	Clause with Generating Performance Incentive Factor;
16	Docket No. 950002-EG, Energy Conservation Cost Recovery
17	Clause; Docket No. 950003-GU, Purchased Gas Cost
18	Recovery Clause; and Docket No. 950007-EI, Environmental
19	Cost Recovery Clause. The purpose of the prehearing
20	conference is described in the notice.
21	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. We'll take
22	appearances at this time.
23	MR. SCHIEFELBEIN: Wayne Schiefelbein, with
24	Gatlin, Woods, Carlson & Cowdery, appearing on behalf of
25	Chesapeake Utilities Corporation.
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MR. COSTA: Matt Costa of Macfarlane, Ausley, Ferguson & McMullen, P.O. Box 1531, Tampa, Florida 33601, on behalf of Peoples Gas in the 03 docket.

5 MR. HORTON: Norman H. Horton, Jr., Messer, 6 Vickers, Caparello, Madsen, Goldman & Metz, P.O. Box 7 1876, Tallahassee, appearing on behalf of Florida Public 8 Utilities in the 01, 02 and 03 dockets; West Florida 9 Natural Gas in the 02 and 03; and Sebring Gas Systems 10 and South Florida Natural Gas Company in the 11 03 docket.

MR. HOWE: Commissioner Deason, I'm Roger Howe with the Office of Public Counsel, appearing on behalf of the Citizens of the State of Florida in the 01, 02, 03 and 07 dockets.

MS. BROWN: Martha Carter Brown and Vicki D. Johnson for the Florida Public Service Commission Staff in the 01 and 07 dockets.

24 MR. PRUITT: And I'm Prentice P. Pruitt, 25 counsel for the Commissioners.

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MS. ERSTLING: Sheila L. Erstling and Beth 1 Culpepper for the Florida Public Commission Staff in the 2 02 and 03 dockets. 3 MR. SCHIEFELBEIN: And, Commissioner Deason, 4 if I may, for the record, state my appearance on behalf 5 of Chesapeake is in the 02 and 03 dockets. 6 Thank you. 7 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay, very well. Any 8 other appearances? 9 Here again, I apologize for the cramped 10 quarters, so we are going to have to be sharing 11 microphones. But perhaps some of the dockets that are a 12 little less controversial, we may get to proceed through 13 those quite quickly. 14 Ms. Brown? 15 MS. BROWN: Commissioner Deason, it appears to 16 us at this point that the 03 and 07 dockets may be the 17 least controversial, and we suggest that we do those 18 first. 19 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Without any objection, 20 we'll proceed to the 03 docket, which is the purchased 21 gas adjustment docket. 22 MS. ERSTLING: Commissioner Deason, it's my 23 understanding that all of the parties have agreed to 24 Staff's position. However, at this particular time, Doc 25

Horton would like to address us regarding certain 1 changes to several of the companies that he is 2 representing. 31 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Mr. Horton? 4 MR. HORTON: Commissioner, West Florida 5 Natural Gas' position in the 03 docket should be the 6 same position as that shown for the Staff, so we have no 7 objection to the Staff's numbers being shown in our 8 positions in all four issues. 9 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. 10 Mr. Howe? 11 MR. HOWE: And we will agree with Staff on all 12 four issues also. 13 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. 14 Ms. Erstling, where does that leave us at this 15 point? 16 MS. ERSTLING: At this point, I believe that 17 all the issues are stipulated out. We have spoken with 18 Indiantown and St. Joe, which also agrees with Staff, 19 and they are in the process of supposedly sending us a 20 fax that they're positions are in agreement with Staff. 21 And we can stipulate all the issues as being in 22 23 agreement with Staff. COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. We'll just have 24 that reflected in the final Prehearing Order. And it 25

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1	would be my intent, then, to not have any of those
2	witnesses appear at the hearing. Under Commission
3	custom and practice, the prefiled testimony of those
4	witnesses will be inserted into the record and cross
5	examination will be waived; therefore, there will be a
6	full and complete record and then the Commission will
7	have a record upon which to base its decision. And the
8	Prehearing Order will reflect that all issues have been
9	stipulated by all parties, or at least not been
10	questioned by all parties.
11	MS. KAUFMAN: Commissioner Deason?
12	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Yes.
13	MS. KAUFMAN: I agree with Staff's
14	representation. I just wanted to make a correction to
15	the draft Prehearing Order. On Page 7, the first issue
16	that appears there, City Gas' position is that it is an
17	underrecovery rather than an overrecovery, and that's
18	the same position that Staff has. I just wanted that to
19	be clear.
20	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. We will make
21	that correction. And if any other similar corrections
22	that need to be made come to mind, if you will please
23	notify Staff as promptly as possible, I'm sure they'll
24	incorporate any minor changes of that nature into the
25	final Prehearing Order.
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ı	Anything remaining then in the 03 docket?
2	Very well. We will move, then, into the 07 docket.
