665 DOCKET NO. 941044-WS; RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY DECLARING CHARLOTTE COUNTY SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 367, FLORIDA STATUTES - REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FOR PROVISION OF WASTEWATER SERVICE BY INDIGO ISLES MOBILE HOME PARK OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

On September 27, 1994, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County adopted Resolution No. 94-195, pursuant to Section 367.171, Florida Statutes, declaring that as of September 27, 1994, the water and wastewater utilities in that County shall become subject to the provision of the Water and Wastewater Regulatory Chapter 367, Florida Statutes. The resolution was Law, acknowledged by this Commission on November 28, 1994, by Order No. PSC-94-1451-FOF-WS. Pursuant to Section 367.131, Florida Statutes, a utility subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission must obtain a certificate of authorization or an order recognizing the exempt status of the system.

ACK On November 29, 1994, this Commission received an application AFA from the Indigo Isles Mobile Home Park Owners Association, Inc. (Indigo Isles or utility) for a nonprofit association exemption APP pursuant to Section 367.022(7), Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-CAF 30.060(3)(g), Florida Administrative Code. The primary contact person for Indigo Isles is Mr. Jack Shinaver. The mailing address CMU for the above contact person is 9181 Griggs Road #21, Englewood, CTR Florida 34224. The mailing address and physical address for the utility is 9181 Griggs Road #73, Englewood, Florida 34224. The EAG application was signed by Mr. James T. Carey, president of the LEG association.

LIN The application was filed in accordance with Section -367.022(7), Florida Statutes and Rules 25-30.060(1),(2), and OPC. RCH (3) (g), Florida Administrative Code. In addition, the applicant acknowledged Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, regarding false statements. Included with the application was a statement that SEC Indigo Isles is a nonprofit corporation, that it will provide WAS wastewater service solely to members who own and control it, that OTH Indigo Isles will do the billing for such service, and that the service area is located at 9181 Griggs Road #73, Englewood, Florida 34224. Also included with the application were the Articles of Incorporation as filed with the Secretary of State and the Bylaws DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

which documents clearly the requirements for membership, and that the members' voting rights are one vote per unit of ownership. The Bylaws do not show when control passes to the nondeveloper members because it is currently 100% membership owned and the developer is not involved. Further, the utility provided a warranty deed as proof of ownership of the utility facilities and the land upon which the facilities will be located.

Based on the above, an order should be issued within thirty days approving Indigo Isles Mobile Home Park Owners Association, Inc.'s application for exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(7), Florida Statutes, as a nonprofit corporation. In the event of any change of circumstances or method of operation of its wastewater system, Indigo Isles or successor(s) in interest, should be ordered to notify the Commission within thirty days of such change so that its exemption status may be reevaluated. In addition the docket should remain open to process other exemption requests for Charlotte County.
