2. Pursuant to the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Commission") audit of FPL's fuel and purchased power cost recovery clause and generating performance incentive factor for the period April 1994 - March 1995, the Commission Staff has provided to FPL several written requests for information.

3. The materials requested by Staff Document/Record Requests ("D/RR") Nos. 21 and 22 pursuant to the Commission's audit of FPL's records in this Docket are intended to be and are treated by FPL as

proprietary confidential business information as that term is defined in §366.093(3), F.S. (1993).


4. The materials sought by D/RR Nos. 21 and 22 are confidential propriety business information because disclosure of the information concerning contractual data of FPL's vendors would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Furthermore, the disclosure of contractual data would also impair the competitive business(es) of the provider(s) of the information. The materials therefore constitute proprietary confidential business information pursuant to §366.093 (3)(d) and (e), F.S. (1993).

5. D/RR Nos. 21 and 22 are attached hereto as Attachments A and B, respectively.

6. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 (3)(a), F.A.C., this NOI constitutes a temporary exemption from §119.07, F.S. (1993), for the materials identified by the Staff in D/RR Nos. 21 and 22 which are being "obtained" by the Staff as such concept is defined in Rule 25-22.006(1)(e), F.A.C. In accordance with Rule 25-22.006(3)(d), F.A.C., the Commission shall accord the material subject to D/RR Nos. 21 and 22 "stringent internal procedural safeguards against public disclosure."

WHEREFORE, FPL requests the Commission to treat the above-identified materials as confidential in accordance with Rule 25-22.006(3)(d), F.A.C.


