- 3. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.036(7), Florida Administrative Code, Section 364.162, Florida Statutes, and the Order Establishing Procedure in this docket, Teleport Communications Group Inc. ("TCG") filed, on September 1, 1995, a Petition in the above-captioned docket, requesting that the Commission establish "economically viable, nondiscriminatory mutual compensation rates for the exchange of telephone traffic between TCG and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc." and to hold a formal proceeding to determine this issue. TCG also reserved the right to petition the Commission as to other co-carrier arrangements should it fail to reach agreement on these issues with BellSouth.
- 4. As an Alternative Access Vendor that has given notice of its intent to provide local exchange service in Florida and has commenced negotiations with BellSouth on co-carrier carrier issues, MFS-FL has substantial interests that are subject to determination and will be affected through this interconnection proceeding.

5. MFS-FL has not yet filed a petition requesting that the Commission establish co-carrier arrangements in this docket but, in filing this Petition to Intervene, reserves the right to file its own petition should co-carrier negotiations between MFS-FL and BellSouth fail to result in an agreement.

WHEREFORE, Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. respectfully requests that it be allowed to intervene in this proceeding.
