We are a rural community in Naples who are faced with a serious problem concerning our telephone services. We are currently forced to have Immokalee exchanges. As a result we have to pay long distance charges to call our neighborhood schools, hospital, doctors, etc. This causes our monthly phone bills to be enormous.

We are Naples residents and are in no way associated with Immokalee. This is an extremely unfair situation and causes great financial burdens upon us as individuals. We are therefore petitioning the Public Service Commission to Change the existing boundaries to include our community in the Naples exchange.

We are asking you to assist us in any way possible in trying to resolve this unfair situation.

**PETITION TO CHANGE THE EXCHANGE BOUNDARY
 OF THE NAPLES EXCHANGE**

Sandra Glidden, a resident of North Golden Gate, petitions the Florida Public Service Commission to expand the boundary of the Naples exchange to include the areas of North Golden Gate and Corkscrew. In support thereof, Petitioner states the following:

1. Petitioner is a resident of North Golden Gate and a subscriber of United Telephone Company of Florida.

2. The residents of North Golden Gate and Corkscrew currently have Immokalee phone numbers, but the community of interest for these residents resides with Naples. The residents of North Golden Gate and Corkscrew have Naples addresses. The jobs, schools, doctors, churches and other interests of the residents are in Naples.

3. Because we have Immokalee telephone numbers, we are forced to pay long distance charges every time we call Naples.

4. Attachment (1) is a petition signed by forty residents of Corkscrew and North Golden Gate supporting this change in exchange

boundaries.

5. The Commission has ample statutory authority to make the requested change in exchange boundaries.

6. First, section 364.025, Florida Statutes, states that the term "universal service" means an evolving level of access to telecommunications services that, taking into account advances in technologies, services, and market demand for essential services, the commission determines should be provided at just, reasonable, and affordable rates to customers, including those in rural, economically disadvantaged, and high cost areas. It further states that it is the intent of the Legislature that universal service objectives be maintained after the local exchange market is opened to competitively provided services. The requested change of the Naples exchange boundary is consistent with and authorized by the universal service objectives set forth in this statute.

7. Second, section 364.19, Florida Statutes, states that the Commission may regulate, by reasonable rules, the terms of telecommunications service contracts between telecommunications companies and their patrons. One such term of service is the boundary for the local exchange area.

8. Third, section 364.01(4)(a) provides the Commission exclusive jurisdiction in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare by ensuring that basic local telecommunications

services are available to all consumers in the state at reasonable and affordable rates. The current exchange boundary of the Naples exchange, by excluding the residents of Corkscrew and North Golden Gate, is inconsistent with this mandate.

9. Fourth, the Commission's existing jurisdiction over service complaints provides the Commission jurisdiction to correct the unsatisfactory service provided to the customers of Corkscrew and North Golden Gate by virtue of the existing boundary lines for the Naples exchange.

10. It has been over forty years since the exchange boundary for the Naples exchange has been reviewed. In those forty years there have been dramatic changes in the area, and the boundaries of the exchange should be revised to reflect those changes.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests the Florida Public Service Commission to expand the boundary of the Naples exchange to include the areas of North Golden Gate and Corkscrew.

On September 1, 1995, this petition was filed with the Commission requesting that the residents of North Golden Gate and Corkscrew communities be moved from the Immokalee exchange into the Naples exchange.

This docket (951099-TL) is scheduled for the Commission's December 5, 1995, agenda conference. The Commission's Staff is requesting data from United regarding the cost that would be involved in moving these customers into the Naples exchange. This information will be used, along with other information, by the Staff in arriving at its recommendation to be considered by the Commission on December 5, 1995.
