## SSU'S ANSWER TO HERNANDO COUNTY'S PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

SOUTHERN STATES UTILITIES, INC., ("SSU") by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.037(1), Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Answer to Hernando County's Petition for Leave to Intervene (the "Petition") served by Hernando County ("Hernando") on September 26, 1995. In support of this Answer, SSU states as follows:

- 1. The Commission should find Hernando's Petition moot, since the Commission voted on October 13, 1995, to exclude SSU's water and wastewater operations in Polk, Hillsborough, and Hernando Counties ("the Additional Counties") from the instant rate proceeding. As a result of said vote, Hernando no longer has a substantially affected interest in the outcome of this proceeding.
- 2. In the event the Commission does not consider Hernando's Petition moot, SSU asserts that the Commission should not rule on Hernando's Petition until such time as Hernando files the resolution referred to in paragraph 3 of its Petition. Section

120.52(12)(d), Florida Statutes, requires an authorizing resolution before a County represents its citizens as a party in an administrative proceeding, but Hernando has not attached this resolution to its Petition. Therefore, it would not be appropriate to allow Hernando party status until that resolution is filed. SSU reserves its right to object to the adequacy of the resolution which Hernando produces.

3. SSU otherwise denies the allegations in paragraphs 3 and 4 of Hernando's Petition.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, Southern States Utilities, Inc. requests that the Commission deny Hernando County's Petition for Leave to Intervene as moot or, in the alternative, abstain from ruling on the Petition until such time as Hernando County files with the Commission an Amended Petition attaching the resolution required by section 120.52(12)(d), Florida Statutes.
