Thank you for your letter dated October 20, 1995, regarding the Commission's decision to implement stand-alone rates for Southern States Utilities, Inc (SSU).

. .

The Commission's order granting increased rates for SSU based on a uniform rate structure was appealed by Citrus County and Sugarmill Woods Civic Association. On April 6, 1995, the Commission's decision was reversed and remanded by the First District Court of Appeal. The Commission's Motion for Rehearing was denied by the Court. A mandate was issued by the Court on July 13, 1995. SSU filed a petition seeking review of the First District Court Appeal's opinion to the Florida Supreme Court. The Commission filed a Notice of Joinder of SSU's petition in the Supreme Court. However, on October 27, 1995, the Supreme Court declined to consider SSU's petition.

In complying with the Court's mandate, the Commission voted last month to approve a different rate structure for SSU. In so doing, the Commission had to choose a rate structure supported by evidence presented in Docket No. 920199-WS that was consistent with the Court's opinion. We chose a modified stand-alone rate structure. On a going-forward basis, the new rate structure will result in higher rates for some of SSU's customers. Of course, because the Commission's decision involved rate structure only, some customers will experience lower rates. The Commission did not hold additional customer service hearings in the service area because the Commission's decision addressing the Court's remand had to be based on the record developed during the hearings held in 1992.

You may be interested in knowing that SSU has filed a new request for a rate increase for all of its facilities and service areas except those located in the counties of Hernando, Hillsborough, and Polk. The utility has requested rates based on

a uniform rate structure. This rate application is pending and is being considered in Docket No. 950495-WS. During the pendency of this proceeding, the Commission will be holding 15 customer service hearings throughout SSU's service area to receive input from customers.

I have enclosed a copy of the District Court of Appeal's order reversing the Commission's decision, and the Commission's Order addressing the Court's remand. Thank you again for your letter. Please call me if you have additional questions.

Dear Chairman Clark:

I am appalled at the recent Commission decision to abandon uniform rates for customers of Southern State Utilities in favor of so-called stand alone rates. This action will unfairly impact my constituents with enormous increases in monthly water and wastewater bills. In some cases, citizens in my district will suffer increases of more than \$50 per month without any increase in consumption. This is absolutely outrageous.

I am confident that your poor decision is unprecedented in the history of Florida utility regulation. At minimum, citizens facing rate hikes of these proportions should be provided sufficient notice and given the opportunity to be heard in a public forum. By your unilateral decision, made in the safe confines of the Commission's offices, you have denied citizens this right.

Further, it is my understanding that this rate issue is before the Florida Supreme Court for their consideration. Why would you act now before that court renders a decision? Is the Commission under specific court order to abandon uniform rates? I don't believe that is the case.

I urge you to reconsider this action and provide all affected customers the opportunity to provide input. I look forward to hearing from you on this matter.
