
D. Statements of fact, law and policy and a statement of SJNG's position on each issue :

1. What is the appropriate projected end to period total net true-up amount for the period beginning October 1, 1994 through September 30, 1995?

SJNG: An overrecovery of \$9,736.00

2. What is the appropriate Conservation Cost Recovery Factor to be applied to customer bills during the twelve month period ending March 31, 1997.

SJNG: \$0.00494 per therm for residential, \$0.00791 for commercial and \$0.00418 for large commercial.



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
