
On January 29, 1996, DeltaCom, Inc. d/b/a DeltaCom Long Distance Services transferred 100% of its common stock to ITC Holding Company, Inc., a Delaware corporation, whose principal office is located at 1239 O.G. Skinner Drive, West Point, Georgia 31833. DeltaCom will continue to operate its long distance business as a wholly-owned direct subsidiary of ITC and will continue to have its principal office located at 113 South Main Street (P.O. Box 1233) in Arab, Alabama, 35016.

ITC is a very successful telecommunications company which in the past few years has entered into ventures and new businesses that promise to grow and develop in the future. For example, the Federal Communications Commission recently granted three Personal Communications Services (PCS) licenses to ITC to service the Birmingham, Memphis-Jackson and Jacksonville Metropolitan Trading Areas. With the acquisition of DeltaCom, ITC will expand its telecommunications interests to include resale of long distance services. DeltaCom's business and customers will benefit from ITC's substantial experience, expertise and knowledge of the telecommunications industry.
